## TIPS FOR STORING BREASTMILK EVERY OUNCECOUNTS

- Store breastmilk in quantities of 2-5 ounces in bottles or breastmilk storage bags, marked with the date.
- Thaw breastmilk in the refrigerator or by placing the container under warm water.
- Thawed breastmilk can be left on the countertop for 1-2 hours or the refrigerator for up to 24 hours.
- Never microwave or boil breastmilk.
- Do not refreeze breastmilk once it has been thawed.

| Insulated Cooler Bag with <br> Ice Packs | 24 hours |
| Refrigerator | 4 days |
| Freezer Section of Fridge | 2 weeks |
| Freezer with Separate Door | 6 months |
| Deep Freezer | 12 months |
