WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Women 10-45 and pregnant women of any age in the following programs:
 Medicaid
 - o Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)
 - o CHIP-Perinate
 - o Healthy Texas Women

HOW TO GET REPELLENT:

- Contact your pharmacy to see if they are participating in this benefit
- Ask your doctor to send a mosquito repellent prescription to your pharmacy
- Have the prescription filled at your pharmacy

Benefit details: One can or bottle of mosquito repellent is permitted per prescription, with one refill per calendar month. This benefit ends on October 31st, 2016. Prescriptions for mosquito repellent will not count against the monthly prescription limit. Repellent will be provided at no cost to Medicaid clients. CHIP members may pay the generic copay or less if the cost of the repellent is less than the copay. Supply may vary by location.



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
